

Korean Conflict / Cold War
History/Language Arts

Class description: Students will learn the causes of the Korean Conflict and the dynamics of the United States' involvement in the early Cold War period. They will also study the perspective of the sailors aboard the USS New Jersey, which was in commission from 1950 through 1957, through primary source documents, artifacts and pictures from the era. Recorded oral histories of men who served during that time aboard the battleship will supplement the class' learning. Included with this class are pre-lesson materials and assessments which require students to evaluate decisions made by US officials and analyze the response of the average citizen.
